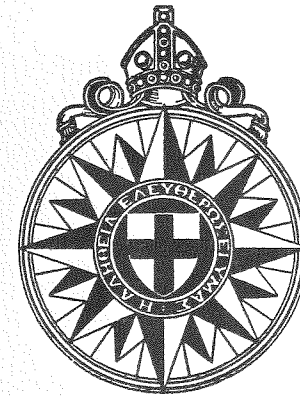

2. Information

An information Desk for the use of Delegates and Official Guests will be maintained at the Royal York (Convention Floor) and Congress Headquarters (Diocesan Centre).

3. Registration

The Registration Office at Congress Headquarters, 125 Adelaide Street, East, will be open from Friday, August 9th to Thursday, August 15th. Information and Transportation Desks will be maintained until August 23rd.

4. Medical Services

The following arrangements have been made for free Medical Services for the Delegates and Official Guests attending the Congress:

(1) Congress Medical Office

- (a) By special permission of the Director, Dr. Wodehouse, the University Health Service Offices have been made available to the Congress. A physician, Dr. J.R. Wilkes, and a Registered Nurse will be in attendance, or available, as follows:

Note: The Health Service Office is on Huron Street below Harbord Street. Huron Street runs north and south, first street west of St. George to the west of the main University campus.

- (b) All Delegates and Official Guests should advise the Congress Nurse at the Health Service Office if they require medical service or if they in an emergency or for other reasons, have received medical attention elsewhere.

- (2) It is anticipated that Delegates and Official Guests who are billeted out of the city or in outlying areas of Metropolitan Toronto may be attended by their host's physician. In such cases this action should be reported to the Congress Nurse at WALnut 3-9644.

5. Housing

The Housing Desk at Congress Headquarters will provide any necessary service and information during the Congress.

8. Transportation Services

Private Car Pool

- (a) Members of the Toronto parishes are most anxious to make the visit of delegates to their city a happy one, and hope that you will take advantage of the voluntary transportation which will be available throughout the Congress for Congress business, shopping, and sightseeing.
- (b) Delegates who are accommodated in private homes may request transportation through their host who will know how this can be arranged. Delegates accommodated in hotels or university residences should complete a Request for Transportation form and hand it in at the Congress Information Desk at the Royal York Hotel by 1:00 p.m. the day before the transportation is required.
- (c) Transportation may be arranged on shorter notice by calling the Transportation Desk at Congress Headquarters (Telephone 364-5371). Delegates are requested to make their applications one day ahead of the requirement whenever possible.
- (d) Because of the excellent public transportation (underground subway) between the University Residences, Discussion Groups, the Royal York Hotel and St. James Cathedral, it is not anticipated that the facilities of the Volunteer Car Pool will be required for transportation between these points.

Departure

- (e) Delegates requiring transportation to Union Station or Airport at the conclusion of the Congress are requested to submit transport requests to their Host or the Transportation Desk at Congress Headquarters by 1:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 21st, so that the heavy demand at this time may be co-ordinated. Please state the time of departure

of your plane or train on the request and note that train schedules show times as Eastern Standard Time (EST), not Daylight Saving Time (DST) which is in effect in Toronto. To convert from City time (DST) to train time (EST) deduct one hour, e.g. 9:00 p.m. City time is 8:00 p.m. train time. Air schedules are based on Daylight Saving Time.

10. Postal

Mail for Delegates or Official Guests received at the Central Office of the Congress, 135 Adelaide Street, East, will be available each morning at the Congress Information Desk, Royal York Hotel.

11. Banking

In Secretariat Release #6 of May, 1963, all delegates were advised to use Travellers' Cheques to provide funds for incidental expenses. Banks in Toronto are equipped to handle Foreign Exchange.

- 12. "ANGLICAN CONGRESS DAILY" -- A special newspaper will be issued at 9:00 a.m. each day August 13th to 23rd except Sunday, August 18th. Free copies will be available to all delegates at five locations on Convention Floor, Royal York, and also at St. James' Cathedral, Congress Headquarters, Education Centre, Gerald Larkin Building and St. Paul's Church, Bloor Street. Up-to-date news coverage, run-down of the day's programme and special events will be featured.

14. Public Transportation

The cash fare is 20¢. Tokens (7 for \$1.00) are usable on either underground (subway), streetcar or bus.

15. Pedestrians

Are urged to cross at intersections and on a green light. Jay-walking is against the law. Motorists drive on the right hand side of the road.

16. Motorists

The speed limit in all built-up areas is thirty miles per hour unless otherwise marked. Unless specifically prohibited, right-hand turns may be made on a red light after coming to a full stop. Watch for pedestrians at intersections and cross-walks.
